## **Carotid Artery Disease**

It is important to accurately document and code carotid artery disease.

## **Documentation**

- ▶ The disease process is appropriate to document and code, even following surgical intervention.
- ▶ The physical exam must match documentation of disease process.

## **Coding Tips**

- ▶ The correct code assignment for carotid artery disease that is **not specified** as due to occlusion or stenosis is **177.9**, **Disorder of arteries and arterioles, unspecified**, since the classification does not provide a more specific code.
- ▶ Use one of the following codes for carotid artery disease that is **specified** as due to occlusion and stenosis:

| Carotid Artery Disease Codes (Due to Occlusion and Stenosis) |        |

| Description  | Code   |
| Occlusion and stenosis of right carotid artery               | 165.21 |
| Occlusion and stenosis of left carotid artery                | 165.22 |
| Occlusion and stenosis of bilateral carotid arteries         | 165.23 |
| Occlusion and stenosis of unspecified carotid artery         | 165.29 |
