## **Congestive Heart Failure**

It is important to accurately document and code congestive heart failure (CHF).

## **Documentation**

Heart failure should be documented as:

- Left ventricular, right ventricular or biventricular
- Systolic, diastolic or combined
- ► Acute, chronic or acute-on-chronic

The true health status of a patient will be accurately reflected when **all chronic conditions are documented and coded specifically**. CMS assigns extra risk value when heart failure is present with other chronic conditions such as:

- Diabetes
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- Chronic kidney disease (CKD)
- Arrhythmias

## **Coding Tips**

- ▶ Use combination codes from I11 and I13, when appropriate, to link heart failure with hypertension or heart failure with CKD (including stage). Review the coding guides related to hypertensive heart disease and CKD on Coding Corner.
- ▶ The ICD-10 code set assumes that heart failure is related to hypertension unless the physician documents otherwise.
